

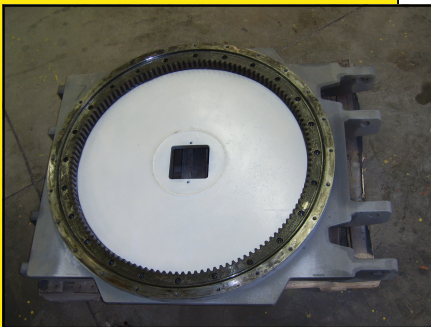
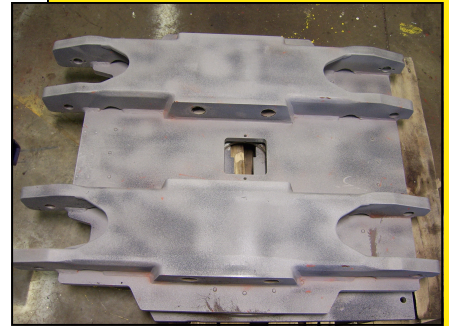
Refurbishing of Clamps

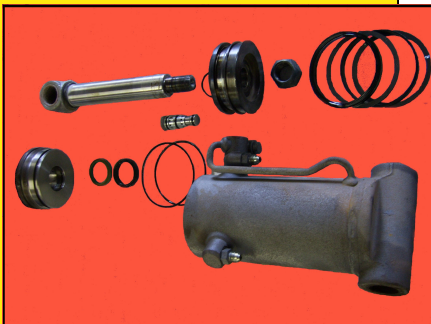

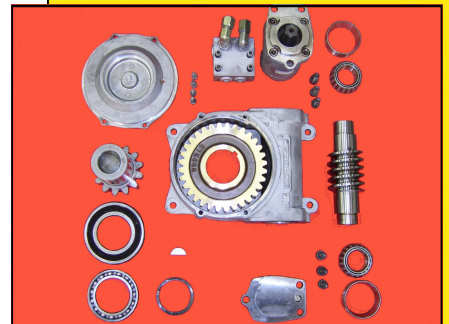
- Complete unmounting of the clamp: base, arms, cylinders, ...

- Replacing the seals in the hydraulic cylinders and in the hydraulic valves.
- Replacing the roller bearings, the seals and the oil in the drive unit.
